SUBJECT: California Highway Patrol Officer Nathan Taylor Memorial Overcrossing

SUMMARY: Designates the Interstate Route 80 (I-80) overcrossing at Baxter Road in the Village of Alta in Placer County as the “California Highway Patrol Officer Nathan Taylor Memorial Overcrossing.” Specifically, **this resolution:**

- 1) Recounts the life and accomplishments of Nathan Daniel Taylor, an officer in the California Highway Patrol (CHP).
- 2) Designates the I-80 overcrossing at Baxter Road at postmile 46.935 in the Village of Alta in Placer County as the “California Highway Patrol Officer Nathan Taylor Memorial Overcrossing.”
- 3) Requests that the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) determine the cost of appropriate signs, consistent with the signing requirements for the state highway system, showing the special designation and, upon receiving donations from non-state sources covering that cost, to erect those signs.

EXISTING LAW: Assigns Caltrans the responsibility of operating and maintaining state highways. This includes the installation and maintenance of highway signs.

FISCAL EFFECT: Unknown, but the resolution requests that Caltrans only erect the appropriate signage upon receiving donations from non-state sources covering the cost.

COMMENTS: Nathan Daniel Taylor graduated from the CHP Academy in 2010 and served in the San Jose and Gold Run areas during his career. Officer Taylor was struck by a vehicle while directing traffic at the scene of a previous accident and succumbed to his injuries the following day, March 13, 2016. Officer Taylor is survived by his wife, three sons, parents, sister, and three brothers. This resolution designating an overcrossing in his honor acknowledges the service and sacrifice of Officer Taylor to his community.
