SUBJECT: Deputy Sheriff Robert “Bobby” French Memorial Highway

SUMMARY: Designates a specified portion of State Highway Route (SR) 50 in the County of El Dorado as the “Deputy Sheriff Robert ‘Bobby’ French Memorial Highway”. Specifically **this resolution:**

- 1) Recounts the life and accomplishments of Deputy Sheriff Robert “Bobby” French.
- 2) Designates the portion of SR 50 in the County of El Dorado from Post Mile .01 to the Latrobe Road Under Crossing (Post Mile .857) as the “Deputy Sheriff Robert ‘Bobby’ French Memorial Highway”.
- 3) Requests that the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) determine the cost of appropriate signs, consistent with the signing requirements for the state highway system, showing the special designation and, upon receiving donations from non-state sources covering that cost, to erect those signs.

EXISTING LAW: Assigns Caltrans the responsibility of operating and maintaining state highways. This includes the installation and maintenance of highway signs.

FISCAL EFFECT: Unknown, but the resolution requests that Caltrans only erect the appropriate signage upon receiving donations from non-state sources covering the cost.

COMMENTS: Sacramento County Deputy Sheriff, Robert "Bobby" French, who was born on January 29, 1965, was killed in the line of duty on August 30, 2017. Deputy Sheriff French was a 21-year veteran of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department, a mentor, and well-respected member of the force. He is survived by his daughter Kaylen Bynoe, her husband Joe Bynoe, their daughter Evelyn, his son Nick French, and his son's wife Heather French, their two kids, Marley and Dallas, his son Kosai French, his sister Lori Mitchell and her husband, Matt Mitchell, and their two sons Landon and Brooks. This resolution designates a specific portion of SR 50 in the County of El Dorado as the “Deputy Sheriff Robert ‘Bobby’ French Memorial Highway in acknowledgment for the significant contribution he made to his community.
